

Circumstances when RVAP staff might be required to disclose information

In some instances involving danger and/or risk of imminent harm to yourself or specifically identified others, child abuse, or dependent adult abuse RVAP staff might be required to disclose certain information in order to protect you and/or others. In certain legal situations (for example, lawful subpoena of your counseling records or your use of mental condition as a legal defense), RVAP staff might be required to disclose information as necessary to comply with the law. If at all possible, RVAP staff will discuss the procedures for doing this with you and enlist your assistance in resolution of the situation that has necessitated such disclosure.
